ITALIAN STUDIES Major Credit Requirements - 60 credits

Italian Studies core courses - 33 credits

Language requirement; - 12 credits

Culture requirements - 6 credits

HST 200	History of Modern Italy

Literature requirements - 12 credits

ITL 211	Survey of Italian Literature in English (1200-1960)
ITL 420	The Language of Love (capstone)

Plus two courses chosen from:

ITL 401	Italian Medieval & Renaissance Literature (1100-1527)
ITL 402	Modern Italian Literature (1527-1890)
ITL 403	Twentieth Century Italian Literature

English Writing Requirement: - 3 credits

One of the following:

ITL 302	Major Writers in Translation I
or ITL 304	Major Writers in Translation II

Italian Studies upper division electives - 27 credits

FREE ELECTIVE Credit Requirements - 18 credits*

*Can be used towards satisfying a minor or language requirement, to supplement a major, or to explore other academic areas.

In addition to the General Education language requirements of ITL 101, ITL 101 LAB, and ITL 102, Italian Studies students must also complete Italian 102 LAB. Students may be exempted from all or part of the Italian language requirement by virtue of competency demonstrated through proficiency placement examinations. An exemption from the Italian language requirement does not yield any credit unless the exemption is based on successful completion of college courses.
